- **Mungell's Pond** – Overgrown ponds, adjacent with A329(M), accessible via main centre, or fisherman's car park, which is bear left at adventure playground past hedgerow on left <https://goo.gl/maps/wmrGH34ADgXK164B7>
- **Mortimer's Meadow** - Grazed grassland West of Loddon, flanked by Bader Way, flooded in winter has many hedgerows and tree lined river <https://goo.gl/maps/kFLgMTy5Pm9KansN9>
- **Redwood Lake** - Western most area of DP, accessed via Redwood Avenue, or crossing Bader Way from Mortimer's Meadow (dangerous due to high speed traffic). Wood lined old orchard, pools <https://goo.gl/maps/WnQi6FpN68kBPMUw5>
- **The Moors** – Old boggy pond totally enclosed by trees and scrubby vegetation, <https://goo.gl/maps/XrGbxXdBYzzHthXe7>
- **Aviation Museum & Copse** - At the top of Bader Way, has it's own car park used by lots of dog walkers, but the copses there are ancient <https://goo.gl/maps/nQq88AskTssuaGBHA>
