Lavell's Wetland Trust (L.W.T.) Code of Conduct for using
'Ron Bryant Hide' & 'Renton Righelato Viewing Screen'

BY USING THE HIDE(S) YOU AGREE TO THESE TERMS

Security

- **NEVER LEAVE THE HIDE UNLOCKED OR WINDOWS OPEN**, L.W.T. RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REVOKE ACCESS TO RON'S HIDE, FOR ANYONE FAILING TO DO SO.
- **If one padlock becomes faulty, THE HIDE MUST BE SECURED, the outer gate is secondary. Please notify L.W.T. immediately of any faulty locks**
- If you find the hide unlocked, notify L.W.T. **immediately call 07855 333616**
- If you see suspicious, or antisocial individuals/groups around DP hide(s), call the DP office on 0118 934 2016. Call the police immediately on 999 if you witness vandalism.
- If you see unauthorised persons on the landfill, lake, or in the hide notify L.W.T. immediately via WhatsApp, or email lavellswt@gmail.com

Entering

- The padlocks to the entry gate and to the hide door use the same code. Align the numbers with the line, to release simply pull shackle up, **remove and take the padlocks into the hide and keep them safe and out of view from non members** - If you feel safer with the outer gate locked behind you this is also acceptable, but you must not reveal the code.

Diligence

- If you are the only person in the hide and another person arrives, do not assume they are a member, before leaving politely ask them for the current combination code, if they cannot provide the code, they must leave when you do
- Before you leave, please double check **ALL viewing windows are fully closed and securely bolted**
- Replace the locks **facing the correct way out, reading from left to right**, close and **scramble the numbers – DO NOT LEAVE LOCKS ONE DIGIT OFF THE CODE**

General

- Access to the Ron Bryant hide is provided for paid up L.W.T. members
- L.W.T. members can bring guests occasionally, they must leave with you
- People passing by can come in while a member is present, ALL must leave when you do
- Smoking and the consumption of alcohol in the hide are not permitted
- Dogs must be kept on a lead
- If past failures to lock the hide continue, L.W.T. may have no choice but to deploy CCTV to record the arrival and departure of members, establish whom is responsible and issue a 'yellow card' denying access for a set period
