

## Mortimer's Meadow



Parking is limited in Colemansmoor Road and Redwood Avenue, so if in doubt Aviation Museum car park is about a 10-minute walk to the cattle grid at the North end.

The whole area is under watched and may be quiet at certain times of year, but worth keeping an eye on during migration.

The meadow South of the 'Large Hedgerow' attracts Whinchat in the autumn – at which time the whole is worth checking for Redstart, Spotted Flycatcher and numerous Tits and Warblers.

The same can be said of the footpaths around the South side of the Moors and towards Redwood Lake and, being an old orchard, is good for Bullfinch, Coal Tit, winter Thrushes and some Finches, with Firecrest being seen near the Moors in recent winters.

The Loddon river footpath offers good opportunities to find Kingfisher all year and winter Siskin & Lesser Redpoll can often be found in the Alders
